

Recommended Activities

ATV Tours

Explore the Big Island on an ATV. Various tour options are available such as enjoying a spectacular scenery ride, on top of 200 foot sea cliffs, or a wonderful combination of dramatic ocean coastlines and Hawaii's oldest rainforest and waterfall ride. Other location would allow you to absorb history while observing beautiful landscapes and stunning vistas, riding the Parker Ranch where Paniolos (cowboys) and horses first met 150 years ago. Must be 16 years and older to operate own ATV. Mule rides are allowed for children of 8 years and older

Boat Tours

Several boat tours are available to guests of the resort, ranging from inflatable rubber raft adventures to a 60-foot double deck catamaran cruise.

Deep Sea Fishing

The Kona Coast is known for its Deep-Sea Fishing - charter a fishing boat and do both fishing and snorkeling along the beautiful Kailua-Kona and Kohala Coast. See both white and black sand beaches and take your chances at fishing for marlin, Ahi (tuna) and more!

Helicopter Tours

Various helicopter tour options are available, the most popular are the Hawai'i Island Spectacular, a two hour trip to the Volcano, offering close-up views of the active Puu O'o vent and surrounding area, returning along the scenic Hamakua Coast, and the Kohala Coast adventure, providing an exciting tour of the many mountain valleys and steep ocean cliffs.

Horseback Riding

Beautiful scenery and safe riding conditions are offered to guests of the Four Seasons Resort. Guests can explore lush pasture lands and ancient Hawaiian sites or picturesque WaipioValley, with stream fed taro patches and an ocean side sandy beach.

Island Tours / Hiking Tours

Various island tours available to guests of the Four Seasons Resort range from around the island excursions to personalized hikes into remote rainforests with trained guides. Guests are able to arrange tours of Kona's Coffee Plantations, Historic Sites, Volcano Hiking Trails and Star Gazing from atop Mauna Kea's 13,796 foot summit just to name a few

Kayak Tours

An assortment of different Kayak tours are available, on your own or guided. The calm waters of Kona offers ideal kayak conditions. Organized tours provide kayakers access to remote areas, including hidden beaches and scenic sites.

Luaus

Expertly prepared Kalua pig is the central theme of Luau cuisine, embellished with a wide selection of delectable. Hawaiian chants, dance and music add a festive quality to the night, not to mention a few tropical blend

Outer-Island Tours

Explore the other islands - play golf at Lanai, have dinner on Maui, visit the Arizona at Pearl Harbor, or explore Na'Pali Coast - these towering volcanic cliffs and emerald valleys with secluded beaches are wonderful and unspoiled.



Private Charter Sail
