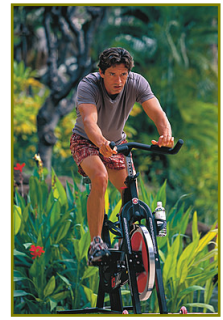

Take a tour of the Tropical Fruit Garden as you stroll through groves of fragrant fruit and tropical trees, pineapple fields, citrus groves, banana and taro patches. Located at Four Seasons Resort Lānaʻi, The Lodge at Koele, these tropical plants and trees are representative of food sources and staples used today in Hawaiʻi and Pacific Polynesia. A map for your self-guided tour can be provided by our concierge desks at either property.

Our highly recommended guided tour is also available on Thursdays at 10:30am with advanced reservations.

Much of the landscape was born out of island owner David Murdock's love for the outdoors. Chief architect Arnold Savrann worked alongside landscape architect Julie Walters to create Four Seasons Resort Lānaʻi at Manele Bay's current layout with bountiful gardens and tropical landscapes. While each garden has its own theme, the element that connects them all is water.

Waterfalls, streams & koi ponds give the illusion that each garden is connected to the next. Mr. Murdock also happens to possess one of the world's largest orchid collections. This too was an inspiration for the planting that was chosen throughout Four Seasons Resorts Lānaʻi at Manele Bay and The Lodge at Koele.

GOLF



THE CHALLENGE AT MANELE

FEATURES:

Designed by the legendary, Jack Nicklaus, The Challenge at Manele golf course is a perpetual gift to all golf enthusiasts who visit the Island of Lāna‘i. The course features 3 holes constructed on the cliffs of Hulopo‘e Bay which use the Pacific Ocean as a dramatic water hazard. The five-tee concept challenges even the best golfers with precise tee shots over natural gorges and ravines, while the resort golfer will enjoy beautiful ocean vistas without suffering limitations on distance and accuracy. The number 12 Jack Nicklaus “signature hole” plays from a cliff 150 feet above the crashing surf, requiring a demanding 200-yard tee shot across the ocean. First tee time of the day is 7:10 am.

THE EXPERIENCE AT KOELE

FEATURES:

Designed by professional golfer Greg Norman, and renowned architect Ted Robinson, The Experience at Koele takes full advantage of the natural lush terrain surrounding the course, and plays upon the dazzling island views of Maui and Moloka‘i. Built on 163 acres, leaving untouched as much of the island’s flora as possible, the course is designed to take advantage of its natural terrain. The back nine holes meander across high country at an altitude of 2,000 feet. The “signature hole,” Number 17, plays from a 250-foot elevated tee to a fairway bordered by a lake along its right side, and trees and dense shrubs along its left. The front nine moves dramatically through ravines wooded with pine, koa, and eucalyptus trees. Water features, a Ted Robinson trademark, are everywhere: seven lakes, flowing streams with cascading waterfalls, and one green, Number 8, that is completely surrounded by a lake. First tee time of the day is 8:10 am.

Lānaʻi: Experience the Island of Lānaʻi from the air. Depart from Lānaʻi airport to Kaunolū. Located on the southern tip of the island, Kaunolū was an ancient Hawaiian fishing village that later became the summer palace of King Kamehameha I. Continue along the southern sea cliffs and explore the unique rock formations known as “The Three Sisters” and “Cathedrals”. Venture across the island’s interior and see herds of wildlife and the “Garden of the Gods”. Sculpted by the elements, this small desert of red rock formations evokes eerie god-like images. Once you reach the rugged north shore, you will discover miles of spectacular remote beaches and the famous ship wrecks that have remained stranded on the coral reef for over sixty years. Continue your journey to the island of Molokaʻi or Maui.

Molokaʻi: Molokaʻi’s spectacular north shore boasts the world’s tallest sea cliffs towering some 3,000 feet from summit to shoreline. Discover the remote Kalaupapa Peninsula where Father Damien aided so many with Hansen’s disease (commonly known as Leprosy). Hidden valleys and plunging waterfalls provide stunning scenery for one of the most spectacular aerial tours on earth.

West Maui: Explore the lush West Maui Mountains and discover incredible wonders. Weather permitting; highlights include the “Wall of Tears” with over 17 waterfalls flowing at once. Maui’s tallest waterfall, Honokohau Falls, over 1,100 feet. Includes views of Launiupoko and Ukemehame valleys. Take in Old Lahaina Town and the resorts of Kaʻanapali and Kapalua. Whale watching in season. West Maui is home to one of the wettest places on earth. Streaming waterfalls and vibrant green valleys are trademarks of this incredible volcanic wonderland.

Haleakala: Travel through Maui’s most remote areas with views of Haleakala’s magnificent crater, Hana Town, the Seven Pools, fabulous coastline waterfalls and world famous Hoʻokipa windsurfing beach on the return. Ascend the world’s largest dormant volcano and discover its immense moonlike crater, large enough to house the entire island of Manhattan from Wall Street to Harlem. Haleakala, literally “house of the sun”, offers views of pure iron oxide cinder cones towering over 1,100 feet tall.

All Flights Include: Ground briefing, personally narrated tour, air-conditioning, complimentary coffee, choreographed CD music through rich stereophonic headsets with volume control. A DVD of your actual flight is included.

HIKING



KOLO'IKI RIDGE NATURE HIKE

Guided hikes are available 7 days a week from the Lodge at Koele.
Sunday to Tuesday – 11:00am start time
Wednesday, Friday and Saturday – 8:30am start time
Total distance is approximately 5 miles round trip.
\$25.00 per person includes bottled water and a snack.

Enjoy the solitude of Lānaʻi as you begin your hike through the forested hills and valleys of the Koele uplands. The forest canopy, with its filtered sunlight, finally gives way to open vistas and steep ravines once carved by flowing streams. Before you, two valleys drop sheer on both sides of the center ridge as the islands of Molokaʻi and Maui thrust skyward across the northern horizon. This hike is also available as a self-guided tour. Please check in with the Koele Concierge Team who will get you started.

FISHERMAN'S COASTAL TRAIL

Enjoy Lānaʻi's natural beauty and breathtaking coastline. This hike departing from the Four Seasons Resort Lānaʻi at Manele Bay will expose you to Lānaʻi's unique geography. Hike along the beautiful Manele shoreline, and enjoy a great workout at the same time. Total hike time is normally 1.5 hours round trip. The Fisherman's Coastal Trail is a self guided hike; please see the Concierge for more information.



PU'U PEHE (Sweetheart Rock)

Total distance is approximately 1 mile.

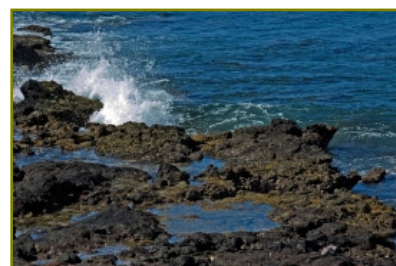
Reached by following the shoreline on the left side of Hulopo'e Beach. A large cove lined with a white sand beach featuring a stone stack known as Sweetheart Rock or Pu'u Pehe.

Pu'u Pehe is the setting of a Hawaiian legend of a maiden so beautiful that her husband kept her in a sea cave lest others steal her away. They lived happily together until one day, while he was in the mountains fetching water, a storm

surf surged into the cave and drowned the maiden. Heartbroken, he buried her atop the virtually inaccessible rock, now called Pu'u Pehe after the maiden, then leaped to his own death.

THE TIDE POOLS AT HULOPO'E BAY

Hulopo'e and Manele were once ancient Hawaiian villages dating back to 900 A.D. The tide pools on the edge of Hulopo'e Bay are wonderful places to discover fascinating inhabitants of these "natural aquariums." The best time to explore is when the tide is low and going out. Carry a tide pool guide booklet with you and enjoy this short easy hike.

HORSEBACK RIDING - THE STABLES AT KOELE

Available ride times: Morning Ride from 9:00 am to 11:00 am; Afternoon ride from 1:30 to 3:30 pm

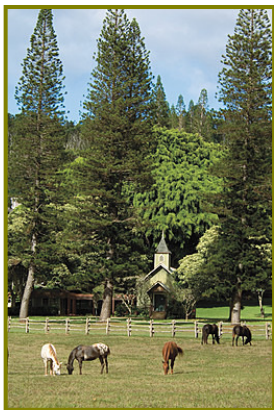

The ride progresses at a leisurely pace, but previous riding experience is recommended.

Hula Lessons & Lei-Making

The Hawaiian people have inherited a rich tradition of *hula* (dances) and *mele oli* (chants), full of stories of gods and goddesses, ceremonies, prayers, protocol, imagery, wisdom, and intelligence. This tradition teaches how to respect family, appreciate natural phenomena, memorize lengthy chants, love the land, understand hierarchy, recognize life and death cycles, and acknowledge and honor the presence of life.

Hula was performed before the Europeans came and was a fun and sacred thing to do. Certain hulas were looked at as being very sacred and only performed at a specific time, for a deity at ceremonies. Other hulas were done at the birth of a child — a song was composed and the hula was done for that particular event. Hula is the heartbeat of the Hawaiian people, preserved by Hawaiian women. Hula is not just a dance, but it is a way of life.

hu·la (hū'la) n. – dances. a Polynesian dance characterized by undulating hips, miming movements of the arms and hands, and usually accompanied by rhythmic drumbeats and chants.

mele oli (mā'la ō'lē) n. – songs and chants

The lei custom was introduced to the Hawaiian Islands by early Polynesian voyagers, who took an incredible journey from Tahiti, navigating by the stars in sailing canoes. With these early settlers, the lei tradition in Hawaii was born.

Leis were constructed of flowers, leaves, shells, seeds, nuts, feathers, and even bone and teeth of various animals. These garlands were worn by ancient Hawaiians to beautify themselves and distinguish themselves from others. The Maile lei was perhaps the most significant. Among other sacred uses, it was used to signify a peace agreement between opposing chiefs. In a heiau (temple), the chiefs would symbolically intertwine the green Maile vine, and its completion officially established peace between the two groups.

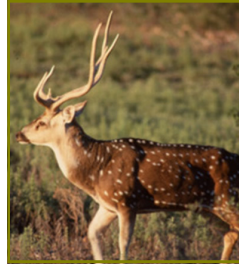
With the advent of tourism in the islands, the lei quickly became *the* symbol of Hawai'i to millions of visitors worldwide.

HUNTING

The Island of Lānaʻi offers year-round Axis Deer (chital) hunting. These are magnificent animals weighing up to 275 pounds, and can carry six-point antlers measuring up to 36" along the main beam. Although polished antlers can be found year-round, the vast majority of bucks display hard racks from April to November. Axis deer venison is excellent eating and is featured on resort menus. These are hardy animals and we recommend any accurate flat-shooting caliber from 243 and up. Success rate is high for hunters with a guide. Also offered year-round is Mouflon Sheep hunting. The Mouflon is said to be one of the two ancestors of all sheep breeds today. Introduced to Lanaʻi in the 1960's, Mouflon Sheep now occupy the more arid North and West coasts of the Island.

The hunting terrain on the island is steep, rocky and bushy. Comfortable boots with ankle protection are recommended along with tough jeans and a light, drab colored, long-sleeve shirt. Some physical conditioning is advised because hunters will usually encounter hot, humid weather and rough hiking conditions.



Hawaiʻi State hunting license for non-residents

All hunters without a Hawaiʻi Hunter Safety Certificate are required to have a letter of exemption to purchase a hunting license. All hunters must purchase a Hawaiʻi State Hunting License. Hunter Safety Certificate required.

Between the months of December to May, many North Pacific Humpback Whales make Hawai'i their home. They spend the summer months in the nutrient rich Alaskan waters feeding and the winter months in warmer waters mating and calving. The Humpbacks migrate to Hawaiian waters (over 3,500 miles) which offer a relatively shallow and protected environment with warm waters and few predators.

MOLOKA'I DAY TRIP

One and a half million years ago two large volcanoes pushed through the surface of the Pacific Ocean and created the island of Moloka'i. Moloka'i is the fifth largest island in the Hawaiian archipelago: 38 miles long and 10 miles wide. Over eons, the north side of the island eroded and fell into the sea, leaving behind the vertical sea cliffs which today make up most of Moloka'i's spectacular North Shore.

Moloka'i was renowned for the wisdom and power of its religious leaders, greatly respected and often feared by others in the archipelago. In the 1500s, the famous prophet, Lanikaula, was so revered that pilgrims came from all the islands to seek his wisdom and advice. Moloka'i became a place of retreat, protected from war by its religious prestige.

Legend tells us that Laka, goddess of the hula, gave birth to the dance on Molokai, at a very sacred place in Ka'ana. When Laka died, her remains were secretly hidden somewhere beneath the hill, Pu'u Nana. The hula was finally established, the work of Laka was complete, and the dance flourished throughout Hawai'i. Moloka'i was praised as "Moloka'i Ka Hula Piko," Moloka'i, the center of the dance.

THINGS TO DO AND SEE ON MOLOKA'I

Kalaupapa

In 1865 the Kalaupapa peninsula was chosen by the kingdom of Hawai'i as the place of exile for Hansen's disease patients. A contributing factor was its isolation; surrounded on three sides by ocean and on the fourth side by the steep cliffs, the peninsula could be reached only by boat or on foot.

Kalaupapa National Historical Park was established by Congress in 1980. It is best known for the Leper Colony, less known for the significant habitats, plants and animals. Several areas in the park provide rare native habitats for threatened or endangered Hawaiian plants and animals. Within the park are hundreds of archeological sites. There are numerous large temples (heiau), agricultural terraces and walls, fishing shelters, stone slides (holua), and a rare canoe ramp. Kalaupapa's greatest asset is its people. It is still home for many Hansen's disease patients that keep the history of the settlement alive through their memories and experiences.

Kalaupapa Mule Ride

Ride the famous Moloka'i mules down the world's highest sea cliffs (1,700 feet) to the Kalaupapa National Historical Park. Even the most seasoned travelers cherish this tour as one of their most memorable island experiences. The boundless beauty you will experience as you traverse down the 2.9 mile trail, leaves most folks absolutely speechless. It is one of the world's most spectacular scenic tours!

The park is open Monday through Saturday. Visitors must be at least 16 years of age. See Kalaupapa National Historical Park and the isolated Kalaupapa community, site of Father Damien's ministry.

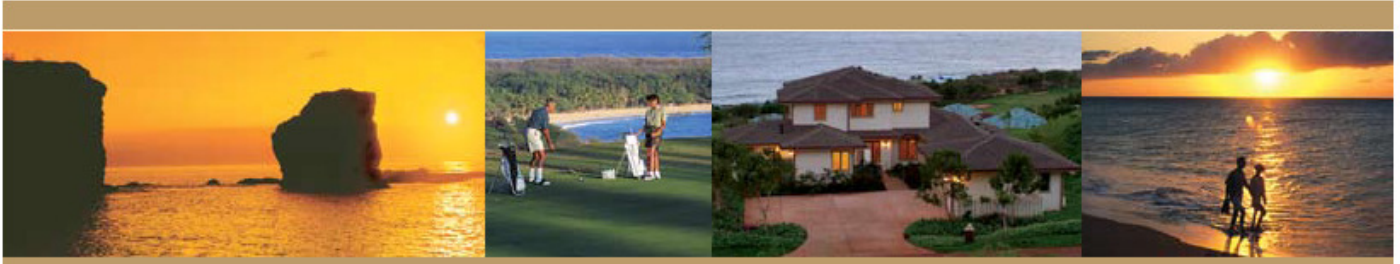

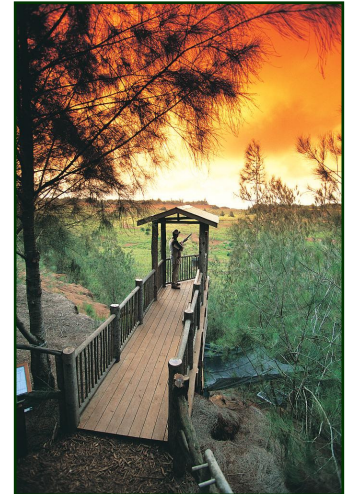
