BY LAND:

ART TOUR:

Our gorgeous island has lent its inspiration to a plethora of world-renowned artists, many of whom have made Maui their home. Meet Maui's most celebrated artists in their private homes and studios with Maui Art Tours. A personal docent and chauffeur will guide you through this unique private tour, especially designed for you. You may choose to enhance your experience by selecting Maui Art Tour's newest art-spa package, where you will incorporate a massage, facial, and use of Maui Spa Retreat's facilities into this enlightening day trip! Visit the concierge to view a portfolio of various artists participating in the program.

BIKE TOURS

Experience Haleakala from summit to seaside on this unique biking tour. The adventure begins atop the world's largest dormant volcano (10,023 feet in elevation!), where you will take in unparalleled panoramic views. Then, from approximately 6,500 feet, enjoy coasting down a guided descent of 28 miles, on which you will encounter countless visual wonders. For a truly once-in-a-lifetime viewing experience, choose the sunrise tour. Midday tours are also available for those who would rather not start the trek in the wee hours. Bikers must be at least 12 years of age and at least 5' in height. This tour is not advisable for those who have back or neck injuries, are pregnant, or who are beginner bikers.

BOTANICAL GARDENS

Treat your senses to a floral delight at the following botanical gardens:

Kula Botanical Gardens Located in the island's rural upcountry area, Kula Botanical Gardens' 6-acre garden boasts over 2,000 species of indigenous flora and fauna. At 3,300 feet in elevation, the temperate climate lends itself to facilitating tropical and semi-tropical plant-life alike. The garden also includes a koi pond, a Jackson chameleon exhibit, and an aviary, which is home to nene geese, African cranes, and other unique birds.

Garden Admission: Adults—\$10 Children (ages 6 to 12)—\$3

Enchanting Floral Gardens Blanketed by a wide variety of tropical and semi-tropical plant and flower species from around the world, Kula's Enchanting Floral Gardens' is an 8-acre botanical paradise. Located at 2500 feet in elevation, this pleasant garden offers visitors exotic flora such as proteas, jade vines, hibiscuses, and orchids as well as an impressive array of fruit trees. Photographers and nature lovers alike will enjoy a stroll through these magnificent grounds.

CAR RENTAL

Explore Maui on your own terms by renting a vehicle. The concierge desk is a satellite desk for Budget Rent-A-Car, and you may pick up and return a rental vehicle at the resort. HIKING TOURS

Become acquainted with Maui on a level most visitors will never experience. Naturalists will escort you deep into the island, where you will encounter the untouched beauty of Maui. Along the way, wilderness experts will share stories of our island's captivating history and lore as well as verse you on indigenous species of plants and animals.

Choose between a lush rainforest and waterfall adventure or a hike into Haleakala's colossal volcanic crater. Hikers must be at least 5 years of age for the easiest hikes, older for more demanding tours.

HORSEBACK RIDING TOURS

Whether you seek lavish flora, rushing waterfalls, rolling ranchlands, volcanic lava fields, or our magnificent crater, you can discover the island's diverse ecosystems *paniolo*-style. Saddle up for a fantastic horseback-riding adventure, on which seasoned wranglers will relay the intricacies of Maui's unique cowboy culture. Trips range from 2 hours to 3¹/₂ hours in duration. This tour is not advisable for those who have back or neck injuries or who are pregnant. Riders must be at least 8 years of age to participate.

For our littlest cowboys and cowgirls, Piiholo Ranch offers pony rides for children 3 years of age and older, lessons for children 5 years of age and older, as well as seasonal wrangler day camps for children ages 8 through 12 years of age.

IAO VALLEY

A tropical, lush landscape awaits you just 30 minutes from the resort. Echo the footsteps of ancient Hawaiian warriors in the culturally rich valley where King Kamehameha destroyed the Maui army in his efforts to unite the Hawaiian islands. Stroll along easy walking paths to discover native flora, a bubbling brook, and, of course, the famed Iao Needle, rising 2,250 feet in elevation. After your walk, visit the interactive nature museum, designed to enhance your Iao Valley experience.

LAND TOURS

Capture the beauty of Maui in the comfort of a luxury passenger van or tour bus. Following are the island's two most sought after destinations:

Hana Conquer the 617 hairpin curves and 54 one-lane bridges of the famed Road to Hana. This full-day journey offers glistening waterfalls, tropical flora, and lush seacliffs—all a stone's throw away from the winding road. Points of interest are abundant along the way, giving you the opportunity to revitalize your senses with an invigorating waterfall swim, stroll through a botanical garden, picnic at Wainapanapa black sand beach, and share in the magic of Hana. Round-trip drive time to Hana from the resort is six hours.

Haleakala The House of the Sun, our majestic Haleakala, inspires even the most experienced of travelers. Atop the mountain, discover volcanic landscapes, cinder cones, native birds, and rare plant species. The most popular time to visit the summit is sunrise, as Mother Nature's dawn from 10,023 feet above sea-level is truly a spectacular show; however, stunning panoramic views are available throughout the day. Round-trip drive time to Haleakala is four-and-a-half hours.

LAVENDER FARM

Despite the nonnative and seasonal nature of the plant, the green thumb of "lavender engineer" Alii Chang has produced a violet wonderland that blooms purple hues year-round. Soothe and revitalize your body and mind as you inhale the natural aromatherapy drifting amongst the fields of 45 magnificent varieties of lavender. Relax on the lanai as you sip lavender tea or lemonade and munch on lavender scone. Join the Walking Tour or the Cart Tour with Alii Chang as your guide. OUTER ISLAND TOURS

Via air or sea, excursions to our accessible neighboring islands can make for extraordinary adventures! Outlined below are outer-island highlights you may not want to miss. Contact the concierge desk for further details and assistance:

Hawaii Treat yourself to a once-in-a-lifetime visit to the home of one of Hawaii's most celebrated goddesses: Pele. Revel in the spectacular visuals produced by the Big Island's constantly active volcano, Kilauea, via aerial tour, or plan a day trip to the island of Hawaii. A full-day land tour will acquaint you with the special ecosystems that 70 million years of volcanism, migration, and evolution have created at Hawaii Volcanoes National Park.

Lanai Cross the Auau Channel via ferry or catamaran to discover a leisurely day on the secluded island of Lanai. With a population of just 3200, Lanai has managed to preserve its culture while offering visitors world-class service. Choose between Expeditions Ferry's golf or land-tour packages or Trilogy's Lanai snorkel-sail. Or, reserve ferry transfers and explore the island of Lanai and its two Four Seasons properties on your own.

Molokai Photographers and nature lovers alike will marvel at nature's grandeur on the island of Molokai. Tour the island on your own or join a guided land tour or hike. Land tours include visits to coffee and macadamia nut plantations, fish ponds, and spiritual sites, and provide stunning views of some of the world's highest sea cliffs. Hiking excursions feature a tour of the historic Kalaupapa leprosy settlement, made famous by folklore about early victims of leprosy and stories of Father Damien's extraordinary courage and love. Hikers must be physically fit (round-trip hike time is 2¹/₂ hours) and over 16 years of age.

Oahu Revisit a piece of American history with a trip to Pearl Harbor. Commemorate the lives of the 1177 lost American soldiers at the Arizona Memorial and explore the Visitor Center. Then, tour the USS Missouri battleship where the armistice ending WWII was signed. Expect an emotional day if you plan to visit this popular Hawaiian tourist destination. SHOWS

The following shows have garnered popular acclaim. Reservations are attainable through the concierge desk:

Ulalena This theatrical production pulls viewers out of place and time and thrusts them into an imaginative world drawn from the deep roots of Hawaiian legend and history. The show explores the relationships between the people, nature, and mythology of Hawaii through original music, Polynesian dance, and acrobatics. Performed by some of Hawaii's most distinguished musicians and performers, Ulalena offers its patrons an experience that is at once universal and unique. Shows are held Monday through Friday, in historic Lahaina town.

Warren & Annabelle's Magic This is no ordinary magic show! The 3¹/₂-hour evening begins in the parlor where you will be entertained by resident ghost, Annabelle, and enjoy cocktails and appetizers on an a-la-carte or package basis. Then, you will be escorted into the theater where magician Warren Gibson will keep you spellbound with his "close-up" magic, side-splitting humor, and Southern charm. Shows are held Monday through Saturday, and guests must be 21 years of age to attend. (Family shows are held on a "seasonal" basis.)

Willie K Dinner Show Enjoy an eclectic performance from Maui's own Grammy-nominated and Hoku-award winner, musician Willie K. The unlikely union between this Maui-raised Hawaiian talent and Wailea's Irish pub, Mulligan's on the Blue, has produced a popular dinner show, held just around the corner, every Wednesday. Dine on the Hawaiian-Irish buffet as Willie K entertains you with music from salsa to country to Hawaiian to rock genres.

Stella's Supper Club

Maui's family-run diner Stella Blues was built around a love for music and has grown into the perfect venue for a supper club every Friday and Saturday evening. Stella's Supper Club features a variety of musicians, all of whom have a popular local fan base. Visitors, too, have come to enjoy this down-home, culinary-musical event. SPORT SHOOTING

Whether it's competitive challenge, a test of ability, or just pure fun that appeals to you, Maui Sporting Clays offers something for everyone. Apart from the breathtaking views that picturesque Ulupalakua Ranch offers its guests, there are over 30 state-of-the-art sporting clay stands, which are adaptable for every level of shooter. Novices and master marksmen alike will enjoy the sport's most popular and challenging stands. Tours are approximately 3 hours in length, and hotel pick-up is available.

SUGAR CANE TRAIN

All aboard for family fun! Historically, steam engines were used to haul sugar cane as well as transport plantation workers, but today, the steam engine has virtually vanished from Hawaii. The Sugar Cane Train recalls the nostalgic charm of yesteryears as it chugs along its six-mile wooden trestle, presenting beautiful views of the West Maui Mountains and panoramic ocean vistas. Contact the concierge desk for current departure schedules from the Lahaina and Kaanapali stations.

WINERY

Embark on a lovely journey through Maui's beautiful upcountry region toward your destination of Tedeschi Vineyards. The island's only commercial winery, Tedeschi Vineyards makes its home in the heart of historic Ulupalakua Ranch. Stroll the magnificent grounds that whaling captain James Makee and his beloved wife designed in the mid-1800s. Sample unique wines inside one of the island's most historic buildings—a cottage that was built for the respite of Hawaii's last monarch, King Kalakaua, and his Queen Kapi'olani. The tasting room is open from 9am to 5pm daily, and complimentary guided tours are offered at 10:30am, 1:30pm, and 3:00pm. No reservations are required.

ZIPLINE ADVENTURES

Soar above Maui on an exhilarating eco-adventure! Maui offers several sites from which to choose: Haleakala tours zip through treetops and over ravines on forested mountainous slopes; Kaanapali tours zip above streams and waterfalls amidst the west side's magnificent panoramic ocean views; and Piiholo tours zip over ravines of eucalyptus and koa trees in the beautiful upcountry area. Highly trained experts will safely lead you through the scenic courses, disclosing historical and cultural lore of the land as well as facts on flora and fauna, creating an adventure to remember. Zipline riders must be at least 10 years of age and weigh between 80 and 260 pounds for Haleakala and Kaanapali tours. Riders must also be at least 10 years of age and between 75 and 275 pounds for the Piiholo tour.

HELICOPTER TOURS

Discover Maui's most remote locations via helicopter. Experienced pilots relay their expertise regarding Maui's history, geography, and ecology on these truly amazing adventures. Choose from the following tours, or, for the ultimate exploration, opt for a private charter:

West Maui Mountains Take wing through the forested deep valleys of west Maui on this 30-minute tour. Long-dropping waterfalls and sharp peaks shrouded in mist will leave you speechless as you discover why Maui is called "The Valley Isle."

VOLCANO AIRPLANE TOURS

BY SEA:

FISHING

Experience the thrill of deep-sea fishing! Target big-game fish, such as marlin, ahi (yellow fin tuna), ono (wahoo), and mahi mahi (dolphin fish). Choose from a private excursion or a "shared" boat, both of which can accommodate a maximum of six passengers. The longer you fish, the better your chances are of catching, so we recommend at least a 6-hour charter (4-hour and 8-hour charters are also available). If you do land a fish, ask the captain for a filet—our chefs would be happy to create a savory entrée for you!

JET SKIING

Ride the warm Hawaiian waters on a single-, double-, or triple-passenger jet ski. Located on beautiful Kaanapali Beach, the island's only jet ski outfitter rents its machines on a ½-hourly or hourly basis. Drivers must be at least 16 years of age and children must be "waist-high" to ride. During whale season—from December 15th through May 14th—jet skiing is prohibited.

KAYAK TOURS

Join Maui Undersea Adventures (our onsite SCUBA/kayak center) for an exploration of the magnificent south Maui coastline. Marvel at exotic tropical fish and serene Hawaiian green sea turtles during the included snorkel. Or, choose another area of the island to explore by kayak with a recommended outside vendor. KITEBOARDING

Popularized on Maui by some of the world's best surfers, kiteboarding offers adventurers an unbeatable thrill! Due to the technicality of the sport, professional lessons are required for beginners, and Maui is the perfect spot to try your hand at this exhilarating activity!

PARASAILING

Fly through Maui skies with West Maui Parasail. Enjoy stunning panoramic views of Maui and our neighboring islands from a 400- or 800-foot line. You can choose to experience this exhilarating ocean ride on either a single- or tandem-harness sail. This activity is not advisable for pregnant women. Children must be at least 5 years of age to ride. During whale season—from December 15th through May 14th—parasailing is prohibited.

RAFTING/ZODIAC TRIPS

Discover the secret coves of south Maui's volcanic coastline via zodiac. This invigorating snorkel adventure explores the sea caves and lava caverns that have lent themselves to a plethora of exotic marine life. In addition to tropical fish and sea turtles, spinner dolphins have made their home on the southern tip of Maui, and sightings are frequent. (Zodiac adventures are also available to the island of Molokini, one of Hawaii's best snorkel sites.) These excursions are not recommended for those who are pregnant or have neck or back injuries.

SCOOTER SNORKELING

Take snorkeling to the next level with the newest underwater rage: scooter snorkeling! Propelled by the scooter (or "dive propulsion vehicle"), you will feel as though you are flying through the warm Maui waters, as you take in the visionary delights of our beautiful reef system. Our onsite water professionals at Maui Undersea Adventures will be happy to lead you on this unforgettable excursion!

At depths of 110 feet, you will likely encounter spotted eagle rays, parrot fish, butterfly fish, and—if you're lucky—even a shark or seasonal humpback whale! This educational, 45-minute underwater tour is fun for the whole family. Tours depart from Lahaina Harbor throughout the day, and advanced reservations are encouraged. Please note that all participants must be 36" in height and physically able to ascend and descend a ladder.

WHALE WATCHING

Every year, between December 15th and May 15th, Maui sees an influx of the island's most beloved marine visitors: humpback whales! An estimated 4,000 to 5,000 whales migrate every winter for mating, calving, and nursing. Nothing is quite as awe-inspiring as sighting these gentle giants as they display such amazing acrobatic feats as breaching, tale slapping, and fluke slapping. Whale watches depart several times daily from both Maalaea Harbor and Lahaina Harbor. Additionally, zodiac and kayak whale watch tours are available. Contact the concierge to determine which is right for you.
